

The Pauanui Sports & Recreation Club Inc. is a Chartered Club and is bound by the conditions of the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 and its amendments. The House Regulations set out herein are intended to minimise personal restrictions on members while ensuring the social and physical comfort of all who make use of the Club facilities. The Pauanui Sports & Recreation Club Inc. does not have reciprocal visiting rights with any other Club in New Zealand.

House Regulations

1. **Admission:**

No member will be permitted onto the Club premises that cannot present his or her current membership card on demand.

2. **Guests:**

Guests may be admitted into the Club lounge on the following basis:

a) **Definition of a Guest:**

Any person not a member of the Club **but** accompanied by a full financial member.

b) **Frequency of admission as a Guest:**

No person can be introduced on a frequent or regular basis. This may be relaxed at the discretion of the General Manager or Manager on Duty at the time.

c) **Conditions for admission of Guests:**

- i) Guests shall be accompanied by a Member who must complete the necessary details in the Visitor's Book and sign the entry in legible form on each occasion the guest is introduced. When the member leaves the Club, the guest must leave at that time.
- ii) A member inviting a guest is responsible for the conduct of the guest and is also required to ensure that the guest is suitably attired.
- iii) A member may introduce a maximum of three guests to the Club on any one visit. If there are valid reasons for wishing to introduce more guests, this should be pre-arranged with the Duty Manager.
- d) The Executive Board has the authority at any time to forbid or suspend the privileges extended to guests, or revoke any approval given under the regulations without assigning any reason.

3. **Dress:**

At all times members and guests are expected to comply with an acceptable standard of dress. The following minimum standards will be strictly enforced:

- a) Footwear must be worn at all times. Jandals and like type footwear is NOT acceptable after 7.00pm during Daylight Saving and after 6.00pm at other times.
- b) No offensive T-shirts / sweaters etc. are to be worn at any time.
- c) No hats will be worn in the Club lounge, women excepted (unless they form part of a uniform or costume that would require a hat to be worn indoors).
- d) Tidy and clean attire must be apparent at all times. Beach and / or similar leisure wear is not acceptable after 7.00pm during Daylight Saving and after 6.00pm at other times.

The Manager-on-Duty has the sole discretion to determine when a member and / or Guests are not complying with the dress requirements of the Club.

4. **Liquor – Bar Sales:**

- a) No liquor shall be supplied to any person so prohibited by the terms of the Liquor Licence held by the Club as authorised by the Sale of Liquor Act 1989 and its amendments.

- b) Liquor will be supplied only to members of the Club and to such guests as may be permitted under these regulations.
 - c) Liquor purchased from the bar will be sold or supplied open and must be consumed on the premises only.
 - d) Members may not bring their own liquor with them for consumption on the premises.
 - e) Liquor won as a sporting competition prize must not be opened or consumed on the premises.
5. **Liquor – Off Licence:**
- a) The Club's Off Licence determines that the Off Licence facility is available to **members of the Club only**.
 - b) Proof of membership must be produced before any purchase can be made.
 - c) Off Licence purchases are not to be consumed on the premises.
6. **Non-Smoking Requirements:**
All indoor areas of the Clubs facilities are deemed to be non-smoking areas.
7. **Juniors:**
Juniors (members under 18 years) are not permitted in licensed areas without parental supervision after 7.00pm.
8. **Snooker Room:**
- a) The snooker room is considered a restricted area and is not available to persons under 18 years.
 - b) Members may not drink adjacent to or over the pool and snooker tables and are asked to return cues to the rack on completion of play.
 - c) Food is not to be consumed in the Snooker Room.
9. **Discipline:**
Any person being intoxicated and deemed to be a nuisance to others in the Club, or using obscene language, or behaving in a disorderly manner or otherwise offending against any rule or regulation, may be required to forthwith vacate the premises at the request of the Manager on Duty at the time.
10. **Gambling:**
- a) No unauthorized gambling shall be permitted on the Club premises.
 - b) The Gaming Act 2003 determines that Minors i.e. under the age of 18 years are not permitted access to or use of gaming machines.
11. **Management:**
The Manager on Duty has full discretionary power to enforce all rules and regulations of the Club. The General Manager is responsible to the Executive Board for the overall operations of the Club.

Members are required to adhere to any decisions made by these persons and to assist them in every way possible.
